STEP 4: CUSTOMER AUTHORIZATION

The San Diego County Water Authority and its member agencies (SDCWA) and the United States Bureau of Reclamation (USBR) sponsor the Irrigation Checkup Program. This Program is managed by Mission Resource Conservation District (Mission) on behalf of the SDCWA.

The Customer is interested in reducing landscape water use on the Property and requests assistance in doing so from the Program. By signing below, the Program’s irrigation specialists have permission to be on the Property for the sole purpose of conducting an irrigation system survey, landscape area measurement, and follow-up site visit. The Customer acknowledges that any advice that may be provided by the Program staff is **based on limited observations** of Customer’s Property and is **only a guideline**. The Customer must: (1) decide if the advice is appropriate; and (2) continue diligent observation, maintenance and management of the site to respond to changing conditions. Mission, the SDCWA, and USBR do not warrant the accuracy of the landscape area measurement.

The Customer agrees that Mission, the SDCWA, and USBR shall not be liable for damages to the property or claims resulting from irrigation system observations, advice or from the Customer’s possible use of Program advice. Mission, the SDCWA, and USBR assume no responsibility for the possible legal establishment of any property/boundary lines, water rights or for area estimates shown or used.

The Customer agrees to hold harmless, defend and indemnify Mission, the SDCWA and its member agencies, and USBR (and each member of their Boards of Directors and their officers, employees, agents and subcontractors) from any liability and claims of any kind (including attorney’s fees and costs) arising out of or in connection with Program activities, including but not limited to liability or claims resulting directly or indirectly from any act or omission of Mission.

Participation in a site visit and checkup is absolutely free of charge for the Customer.

Records Release

The owner, or water account holder, of the above property allows Mission/SDCWA to obtain water use records for this facility as part of the Program. These records will be treated in a confidential manner to the extent it is consistent with the California Public Records Act, Government Code Section 6250 et. seq.
